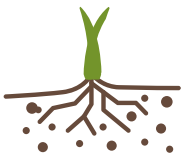

Liners make good horticultural sense.

Liners have limited soil volume, which limits vegetative growth. However, the plant continues to photosynthesize, and the excess energy that is not put into growth is stored for future use. When it comes time for planting into the landscape (or larger containers) liners have stored energy that's ready to go. When planted, liners burst into action, catching up to larger, finished plants in one or two growing seasons.

Liners make good economic sense.

Why spend more than you need to? Liners are far less expensive than gallons so it costs less to cover the same area. If you're interested in planting more densely, double the number of liners and still beat the gallon price.

Because of their low water and fertilizer requirements, most grasses require fewer resources to establish and maintain than other plants.
